About the Centre for Community Child Health

The Centre for Community Child Health (CCCH) aims to support and empower communities to continually improve the health and wellbeing of children and their families. The Centre is part of The Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne, and is a research centre of the Murdoch Children's Research Institute.

The Centre's professional development courses are designed to meet the needs of early childhood professionals, and their content draws on its cutting edge research and clinical work.

Training Topics

Family Partnership Training This is a **5 day** training course in the Parent Advisor/Family Partnership Model developed by Hilton Davis in the UK (see www.cpcs.org.uk). The course enables people working with children and parents to improve their understanding of the helping processes and practise the skills of engaging parents and developing supportive and effective relationships. Training is provided by skilled and enthusiastic facilitators who are committed to the Family Partnership Model.

PEDS- Parents' Evaluation of Developmental Status PEDS is an accurate, reliable tool for early detection of developmental and behavioural problems in children from birth through to eight years of age. It is also a valuable parent engagement tool. This training is designed to teach a broad range of professionals to use this tool in order to begin a dialogue with parents about any concerns they may have about their child's development or behaviour.

Partnerships with Parents: Listening and Responding To Families. An introduction to family-centred practice, designed to heighten service providers' awareness about issues in working with families. It helps practitioners to focus on effective ways of supporting young children and their families.

Platforms Service Redevelopment Framework The CCCH has developed a framework designed to support communities to work towards better outcomes for young children and their families. The framework consists of a range of resources to guide communities through the processes that ultimately leads to a positive network of effective services to promote early childhood development for individual communities. To learn how to use Platforms in your community, the following training is now being offered: Guide to Planning, Implementing and Evaluating a Community Initiative. Extensive materials will be provided with the training.

Customised Training Many organisations and staff groups have specific training needs which may not be met by the schedule and sessions proposed. Customised training enables you to choose a location, topic and a time that suits your needs. Where possible, we will tailor training to specifically meet your requirements.
